The regularly scheduled WCC Board meeting of Tuesday, March 15, 2022, 7:00 p.m. has been CANCELED.

This will be the first In-Person meeting of the WCC since the Governor's mandated closure due to the pandemic and will be held at

Among agenda items will be a Special Guest Presentation by Samuel P. Siegel, Master of Urban and Regional Planning, UCLA Luskin School of Public Affairs. Sam will present his final report, findings, and recommendations of his Capstone Research Project, "Centennial, Cents, and Sensibility," a comparative analysis of historic preservation, traditional urbanism, adaptive reuse, and community cultural practices in Westwood Village and Downtown Santa Barbara, with an additional study of Old Pasadena, and a proposed framework to achieve renewal and revitalization of Westwood Village against the backdrop of the amendments to the Westwood Village Specific Plan currently pending before the Los Angeles City Council and Planning Department, a future update of the Westwood Community Plan, and the 2029 Centennial of the opening of Westwood Village.

Important: please note COVID-19 Protocols below. Please arrive 15 minutes early to comply with Protocols.

COVID-19 Protocols at Belmont Village Westwood: As the Westwood Community Council resumes in-person meetings beginning March 2022, in consideration of Belmont's sensitive population, all persons entering Belmont for the first time must check into a lobby kiosk, type in their first and last name, scan vaccination card with dates of full vaccination including booster (if eligible), and take a forehead temperature check. Kiosk will photograph front and back of vaccination card. Upon approval of photos (for legibility), name will be added to Belmont's preapproved guest list. On subsequent visits only an instant temperature check will be required. All unvaccinated persons may conduct a self-administered on-site COVID-19 rapid test, using either a rapid test kit they provide and self-administer on-site, or they may purchase a rapid test kit from Belmont (\$15 fee, cash or check only) and self-administer on-site, with results given in 5-10 minutes. Upon a negative rapid test and forehead temperature check, guests will be admitted. In accordance with the Governor's mandate, Belmont Village, as a healthcare facility, requires face masks to be worn by all persons at all times while inside the facility, unless eating or drinking.

PUBLIC COMMENT POLICY: In accordance with its Bylaws, the Westwood Community Council (WCC) shall provide an opportunity in open meetings for members of the public to address the WCC on agenda items at the time the respective item is considered. Individual testimony on agenda items shall be limited to two (2) minutes per person. Public comments on all other nonagendized topics of interest to the public which are within the subject matter and jurisdiction of the WCC shall be made during the General Public Comment period, and shall be limited to two (2) minutes per person and up to ten (10) minutes per subject. However, the WCC Chair has the discretion to modify the time allotted for each agenda item and each speaker depending on the number of speaker request cards received and the time available for each agenda item and each nonagendized topic. Items may be called in any order at the discretion of the Chair. EVERY PERSON WISHING TO ADDRESS THE WESTWOOD COMMUNITY COUNCIL (WCC) ON AN AGENDA ITEM MUST COMPLETE A SPEAKER'S REQUEST CARD AND SUBMIT TO THE WCC CHAIR PRIOR TO THE WCC'S CONSIDERATION OF THAT ITEM.
